I READ: Colossians 1:1-14



I READ: Colossians 1:15-29

In these verses Paul taught about the virtue of Christ, that Christ is Lord and God. He is the one who created everything that exists in heaven and in this whole universe. Jesus existed before everything else existed and that is why He is known as Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the one who is and who is to come, the Almighty. God is priority over everything else. Paul also said that the Lord is revealing His secret to His saints. The nations (this world) do not understand this secrets/mystery and for them it remains hidden. What is the mystery/secret? That Christ dwells among us, in the midst of our families, our churches and our communities. And if He dwells among us, then nothing is impossible for us, miracles still exist.

I READ: Colossians 2: 1-10

Once again, Apostle Paul revealed God's secret for the church of God, which is Christ. Any answer that the world needs can be obtained in Jesus Christ, for in Him is hidden all wisdom and knowledge. If we need wisdom and knowledge and answers to solve our problems, then we need to come under God's feet. He will give us a way out and victory. Jesus is the answer! The world does not understand this, because they do not know Jesus. They will seek answers from other sources, they will seek wisdom and knowledge with their own strength. Therefore, we need to continue to be rooted in Christ and grow in Him so that more of His secrets will be revealed to us

I DECLARE: *Colossians 2:3 - for in Him are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge*

ANNUAL BIBLE READING: JOHN 7-9

THURSDAY THE VICTORY OF CHRIST

I READ: Colossians 2:11 - 23

Apostle Paul revealed to the church of God the absolute victories we will experience when we believe in Jesus and His sacrifice on the cross. First, through Jesus' sacrifice on the cross, sin can no longer rule over us, because God has forgiven all our trespasses and nailed all our sins on the cross. Secondly, through His crucifixion the devil has been defeated and Jesus has triumphantly won, and that victory has been given to us, His church. Thirdly, Jesus nailed the curse on the cross, so we no longer need to live under the curse but under God's grace. Jesus freed us from the curse by becoming a curse for us so that our life now is under God's grace and not under a curse.

I DECLARE: *Colossians 2:15 - Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.*

I DO: What actions am I going to take after meditating on the Word of God?

I PRAY: Pray as guided by the Holy Spirit

ANNUAL BIBLE READING: JOHN 10-12

FRIDAY NEW CREATION

I READ: Colossians 3 : 1 - 11

Apostle Paul told us in 2 Corinthians 5:17 that if we believe in Jesus and the work of His cross then we become a new creation. Every aspect of our lives should be renewed in Him, including our spirits, hearts, thoughts, as well as lifestyles. We no longer worry about worldly matters and show more care toward heavenly matters. Matthew 6:33 said that when if we focus on God, He will take care of our needs. It's time that we pay more attention to our relationship with God, His ministry, restoration, and harvest of cities and nations, and many more. Becoming a new creation means that we no longer follow the desires of our old creation flesh. So let's live in God's holiness!

I DECLARE: *Colossians 3:1-2 - If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth.*
