I READ: Jeremiah 23:5-6, Philippians 3:7-11

Jesus Christ is Jehovah Tsidkenu, the Lord our righteousness. We are not able to make ourselves righteous, not even by doing good deeds. The reason is because we can never be perfect. As long as we reside on this earth, the law of sin will pull us perpetually. Jesus Christ is the only entity who was able to complete His task flawlessly. A task bestowed upon Him by His Father in heaven, the work of His Cross. Jesus uttered "It is finished!" to His Father; when He was nailed to the cross. ANNUAL BIBLE READING: REVELATION 9-11

SUNDAY THE POWER OF THE RESURRECTION OF CHRIST

I READ: 1 Peter 1:1-4, Romans 8:11

The resurrection of Jesus Christ provides us believers a life full of hope. What this means is we have a bright life full of success. Additionally, we also receive Heavenly blessings that are untainted and will not wither or fade, such as peace, joy, harmony, truth, protection and the power of the Holy Spirit. MONDAY FREED FROM OUR PAST

I READ: 1 Corinthians 15:1-11

Why did Jesus die for a span of 3 days? The number 3 symbolizes completeness/perfection. The three days Jesus died completed his redemptive work for us in full. At the cross, Jesus laid down his life to his Father in heaven with the phrase "It is finished" as he lets out his last breath. In Greek, the phrase translates to it is finished completely or perfectly. In addition, the number 3 symbolizes the three different perspectives of time: the past, present, and future. The death and resurrection of Jesus represent the victory He has given us for our past, present, and future. The devil acknowledges our weaknesses. He uses our past failures to condemn and torture us. Through His grace, we have been freed from past failures. Jesus has forgiven us and replaced our failures with a future filled with hope.

I DECLARE: *Philippians 3:13-14 - but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus*

I DO: What action will I take today after meditating on the Word of God?

I READ: Matthew 26:36-39, 2 Corinthians 10:5
