## SATURDAY FULLY RELY ON THE LORD'S PROMISES

**I READ:** Acts 1:4-9, Acts 2:1-4

Prior to the Lord's ascension into heaven, Jesus showed Himself to His disciples for 40 days. He instructed them to wait upon the Lord's promise, the gift of the Holy Spirit. During that time, there were 500 of His disciples who heard His message, 1 Corinthians 15 : 6. After His ascension into Heaven, all the disciples went back to Jerusalem and wait upon the promise. They were diligently prayed in unity and fellowshiped together. However, after a great period of waiting time the majority of them started to lose faith and leave their gatherings. The total of the disciple went down to 120 people who were faithfully prayed and wait upon the instruction, Acts 1 : 15. On the tenth day, suddenly the outpouring of the Holy Spirit came upon them. The 380 people who left missed their anointing and visitation at that time.

**I DECLARE:** *Acts 1:14 - These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, [a] with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers.*

**I DO:** What action will I take today after meditating on the Word of God?

**I PRAY:** Pray as guided by the Holy Spirit

## SUNDAY BE FAITHFUL IN SMALL MATTERS

**I READ:** Luke 19:11-27

Today we will learn about the parable of pounds. In this parable, the servant who had five pounds was successful in multiplying his resource so that he was able to acquire ten pounds at the end. He was then rewarded with ten cities to have authority over. For the servant who did not take the opportunity and resource given by his master, he was left with nothing (he did not experience the anointing of God). What was the secret of servants who experienced success? They were diligent and faithful in all the small things that their master entrusted them. They did not take small matters for granted. Even though those things may seem small and insignificant, they continued to be obedient and did them whole- heartedly. In the end, their master rewarded them with something significant in their lives.

**I DECLARE:** *Luke 19:17 – the king replied, 'Excellent!' You are a good servant. Because you have been faithful a small matter, you will have authority over ten cities.'*

**I DO:** What actions am I going to take after meditating on the Word of God?

**I PRAY:** Pray as guided by the Holy Spirit

**I READ:** Joshua 1:1-9

**I READ:** Matthew 25

The 10 virgins in this parable represent the church of God. In this parable, there are 5 wise members of the church and 5 foolish. Why did Jesus call them foolish? because they missed God's visitation. These 10 virgins were expecting the arrival of Jesus Christ, the bridegroom. But only 5 were allowed to accompany Him to the celebration. How were they able to experience God's visitation? Because, they have brought lamps and oil. The lamp represents the Word of God as written in Psalms 119:105. The oil represent the anointing of the Holy Spirit as written in Exodus 29:7. As we wait upon the Lord, we must dwell in His words. We also need to be anointed and filled by the Holy Spirit. We must leave the flesh, the lust of this world and sanctify ourselves.

**I DECLARE:** *Romans 8:13 - For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live.*

**I DO:** What actions am I going to take after meditating on the Word of God?

**I PRAY:** Pray as guided by the Holy Spirit

**ANNUAL BIBLE READING: GENESIS 39-40**

## THURSDAY PRAY WITH FAITH

**I READ:** James 5:16-18, 1 Kings 18:42-45

What can we learn from the life of prophet Elijah? He was an ordinary man, but he shook the entire universe. With his incessant prayer he stopped the rain for three and a half years. Within moments; he was able to bring back the rain. He was able to do so because he prayed a determined and earnest prayer. To experience God's amazing visitation, we need to pray, worship and meditate/declare His words daily. Our prayers must be accompanied by faith and unwavering conviction that God will answer them. Elijah prayed a persistent prayer and did not stop praying until rain came down on Israel.

**I DECLARE:** *Ephesians 6:18 - Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication...*

**I DO:** What actions am I going to take after meditating on the Word of God?

**I PRAY:** Pray as guided by the Holy Spirit

## FRIDAY LIVE IN THE LORD'S CALLING

**I READ:** Hagai 2:1 - 10

When the Children of Israel have returned from exile in Babylon, The Lord reminded them to rebuild the wall of Jerusalem and the Temple of God. The Lord appointed Zerubbabel to lead the Israelites to rebuild the temple in Jerusalem. The Lord's message to Zerubbabel was to focus on the rebuilding of Jerusalem. The Lord also promises them, His spirit will dwell in the midst of them to enable them to complete the task. The Lord has arranged the wealth of nations to pour into Israel to fund the rebuilding project. Through this story we know that God visitation occur when we responded to His calling and focus on completing the task.

**I DECLARE:** *Zechariah 4:6 - This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: 'Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit, 'Says the Lord of hosts.*
