TUESDAY ONE MORE TIME ON GOD'S GRACE

I READ: 1 TIMOTHY 1 & 2

Apostle Paul reminded Timothy to teach the congregation in Ephesians to live in God's grace. God's grace is given to those who believe and who are faithful to the Lord Jesus. All curses and punishments have been borne on the cross by Him. Once sinners, when we start to believe in Him, we are made righteous from our sins and inequity. Believe in Jesus fully and love Him with all of our heart, soul, and strength. Read and meditate on His Word often so that we can know His grace even more and so our faith can grow. He's turned all curses into blessings, and death into life. He died for us so that we can live in abundance, John 10:10.

ANNUAL BIBLE READING: PSALM 35-39

WEDNESDAY TRADITIONS AND GRACE

I READ: Galatians 2

Apostle Paul taught the congregation of Galatia to no longer live according to traditions. One of the Jewish traditions during that time was that all male were required to be circumcised to validate their faith and believe. However, Paul stated that someone is not made righteous because they follow traditions but instead through their faith in Jesus. One example was Titus who was Greek but was not circumcised and Paul did not force him to be circumcised. Paul stated to the congregation of Galatian that the Lord called him to share the gospel to the gentiles. God loves all nations, whether they're Jewish who are circumcised or whether they're non-Jewish and uncircumcised.

I DECLARE: *Galatians 2 : 21 – I do not set aside the grace of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.*

I DO: What action will I take today after meditating on the Word of God?

I PRAY: Pray for the next generation including children and youth in my family and also young generation in America

ANNUAL BIBLE READING: PSALM 40-45

THURSDAY THE KINGDOM OF GOD

I READ: Colossians 1:1-14

The book of Colossians contains the knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ. Paul taught the congregations at Colosse that Jesus has freed His children from the power of darkness. He has defeated the devil and his kingdom; therefore he no longer has dominion over His children. We as His children have been given that victory. Jesus has brought and placed us in His kingdom and away from the devil's. His kingdom speaks of joy, peace, and righteousness (Romans 14:17). His kingdom also speaks of His power (1 Corinthians 4:20). As children of God we will live happy, successful, and peaceful lives because our lives are filled with His power and not of the evil one.

I DECLARE: *Colossians 1:13-14 – He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins*

I DO: What action will I take today after meditating on the Word of God?

I PRAY: Pray for my VIP List. All the people that I want them to receive Jesus as their Lord & Savior.

ANNUAL BIBLE READING: PSALM 46-50

FRIDAY THE LORD IS PRESENT

I READ: Matthew 1:18-25

The Lord Jesus is always present in the midst of us. He is Immanuel, God who is always with us. He is Jehovah Shammah, He will never leave us or forsake us. In His presence we will never feel alone and lonely. Our lives will be filled with hope, joy, blessings, and victory. In the midst of our struggle we will still feel his presence and peace. The problem is that we do not always feel His presence. Why is that? Because we are not as intimate with Him as we should be.
