I READ: 1 Samuel 17:40 – 51, Matthew 16:19

ANNUAL BIBLE READING: NUMBERS 35-36

THURSDAY POWER TO CREATE

I READ: Genesis 1:1 – 25, Romans 4:17, Joshua 1:8

There is power behind the declaration of the Word of God. God created the universe through His spoken words. During creation, there was only darkness that covered the earth. ANNUAL BIBLE READING: DEUTERONOMY 1-3

FRIDAY UNITY

I READ: John 17:20-26, Acts 1:14

As children of God, we need to be unified in the harvest that will happen in this nation. We cannot work at it alone, since this is a great undertaking. But how can we be united? The Word of God, in John, says that the glory of God allows us to be united. If we use our own strength, we are unable to unite, but when we experience God's glory, we will love Him and will be able to set aside all of our pride and unite. God's glory also refers to His love.
