

SATURDAY YOUR KINGDOM COME

I READ: Ephesians 6:10-12, Matthew 6:9-13

Just how the Lord Jesus has His own Kingdom, which is the Kingdom of Heaven, the devil also has his own kingdom. When we declare for God's Kingdom to come, Matthew 6:10, we are defeating the kingdom of the devil. ANNUAL BIBLE READING : ISAIAH 20-22

SUNDAY THE PRAYER TOWER

I READ: Isaiah 62:6-7, Habakkuk 2:1, Daniel 10:14

The way the Tabernacle of David was operated can be applied to how the Prayer Tower is operated nowadays. At the Prayer Tower, we also pray, praise and worship the Lord in Unity Day and night. There, we intercede for nations, cities, and other places such as schools, and workplaces. When we pray in the tower, The Lord will give us His Word, His revelation, His wisdom, His teachings, and answers to our prayers, Habakkuk 2:1, Isaiah 2:2-3. The Lord will also open up the secrets of the nations that we pray for. He will also give us strategies to pray for nations, Daniel 10:14. I DECLARE: *Isaiah 2:3* - Many people shall come and say, "Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, to the house of the God of Jacob; He will teach us His ways, and we shall walk in His paths." For out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.

I DO: What action will I take today after meditating the Word of God?

THE TABERNACLE OF DAVID

I READ: Acts 15:16–17, 1 Chronicles 24–25

When David became the King of Israel, he built the Lord's tent that was called the Tabernacle of David. The Ark of The Covenant was placed inside of it. 1 Chronicles 24–25 explained in detail how David arranged the service order where the priests were given a task to continuously worship and pray for 24/7. There were 288 assigned priests divided into 12 group of people where they took turns to praise and worship for 24 hours. Day and night there was unity in prayer, praise and worship. Through this story, the Lord wants to remind us to rebuild our prayer, praise, and worship to the Lord. Be more intimate and love the Lord more.

I DECLARE: *Acts 15:16* – After this I will return And will rebuild the Tabernacle of David, which has fallen down; I will rebuild its ruins, and I will set it up.

I DO: What action will I take today after meditating the Word of God?

ANNUAL BIBLE READING: ISAIAH 1-4

THE TABERNACLE OF DAVID

TUESDAY BE WATCHFUL FOR ONE HOUR

I READ: Matthew 26:36 – 41, 1 Thessalonians 5:17-19

Maybe we've asked ourselves, how long should we pray? The answer is we are to pray for as long as the Spirit guides us. Maybe we can start with a few minutes which then can increase the more we thirst for Him. One day maybe we can reach to an hour or even more. The Lord reminded His disciples to pray and be watchful for at least an hour. The goal is so that our spirit doesn't fall asleep/die down. This way, the devil cannot lie to us because we are guarded. Peter was not able to pray with Jesus for one hour because he was too sleepy. At the end because his spirit was not on guard, the devil was able to lie to him and it resulted in him denying Jesus three times.

I DECLARE: *Matthew 26:40 – Then He came to the disciples and found them sleeping, and said to Peter, "What! Could you not watch with Me one hour?"*

I DO: What action will I take today after meditating the Word of God?

I PRAY: Pray as guided by the Holy Spirit.

ANNUAL BIBLE READING : ISAIAH 5-7

WEDNESDAY PRAISE AND WORSHIP

I READ: Psalm 34:2–9, Psalm 22:4

These days we need to increase the frequency of our praise and worship to the Lord. The Word of God states in Psalm 22 : 4, the Lord is enthroned on our praises. When He is enthroned, His blessings flows. Psalm 34 states, He will deliver us from all our fears, deliver us from troubles and His angels encamps around those who fear Him. His grace and mercy follow us the days of our lives. Praise and worship Him until He comes down and visits our lives. In the bible, Paul and Silas were freed from the prison doors after they praised and worshipped the Lord all night long.

I DECLARE: *Acts 16:25-26 – But at midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them. Suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken; and immediately all the doors were opened and everyone's chains were loosed...*

I DO: What action will I take today after meditating the Word of God?

I PRAY: Pray as guided by the Holy Spirit.

ANNUAL BIBLE READING: ISAIAH 8-11

THURSDAY UNITY

I READ: Act 1:12-14, Psalm 133

The Tabernacle of David was where prayer, praise and worship were done by the priests, in unity, day and night. These days, The Lord wants to remind His people to rebuild the Tabernacle of David within their private life, family, even all through the nations. The importance of praying in unity is to defeat the demonic power that has been worsen these days. It is not possible to defeat the devil alone, we need to be united in one accord with other fellow believers to be able to achieve victory. Psalm 133 emphasizes that only in unity will His new anointing come upon us and according to the book of Isaiah this new anointing can destroy every bondage. Therefore, let's increase our unity in the midst of us and let us love and forgive one another.

I DECLARE: *Acts 1:14 - These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the woman, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brethren.*

I DO: What action will I take today after meditating the Word of God?

I PRAY: Pray as guided by the Holy Spirit.

ANNUAL BIBLE READING : ISAIAH 12-15

FRIDAY DAY AND NIGHT

I READ: Lamentations 2:18-19, Isaiah 62:6-7

As believers why do we have to pray day and night or without getting discouraged? Both verses above are talking about how God recovered the Jews from a great fall. The Jews had to call upon God in their prayer day and night until God recovered them. Don't be discouraged and don't stop praying until restoration happened in our life. The same situation back then is pertaining to our life and even to our nation these days. Therefore, just like the Jews we must pray to God day and night and beg Him so that restoration can happen in our life. Don't stop praying until we have been restored. PUSH - Pray Until Something Happens.

I DECLARE: *Isaiah 62:6 - I have set watchmen upon thy walls, O Jerusalem, which shall never hold their peace day nor night: ye that make mention of The Lord, keep not silence,*
