

SATURDAY GIVE ATTENTION**I READ:** Galatians 6:9-10, Acts 10:36-38

It is often that the simple things we do for someone that will attract his or attention to us. That was what Jesus did as well when he lived on earth. Jesus walked around doing good, smiling, showing love to the little kids, and hugging the sick. His softness pulled many people to come to Him. When they did so, He healed them, showed miracles, and even fed them so that they received Him as their God and Savior. Don't get tired doing good to others until we can win souls. Showing our attention by simply giving a call or text message, or buy someone's coffee, can be very powerful in having people come to Jesus.

I DECLARE: *Galatians 6:9 - And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart.*

ANNUAL BIBLE READING: ISAIAH 46-49

SUNDAY PROVIDE ASSISTANCE/HELP**I READ:** Romans 12:9-17

In order to win many souls, we need to do good deeds. When others are in need, we should lend a hand easily, especially if they have specific needs. Just like the Lord Jesus, when people were hungry, he fed them. The sick were healed, those who were possessed by the evil spirit were released, He even attended weddings, and so on. The Lord teaches us to pay attention to other people's needs, whether they're in their most joyous day or saddest day. This is stated in Romans 12:15. It would be great to start to pay attention to the people in our VIP list. DAILY WORD**MONDAY****STEP UP****I READ:** Matthew 28:18-20, Luke 12: 11-12, Acts 1:8

Now is the time to go and be sent by God to reap souls. God's message today was for us to not be afraid because God will be with us until the end of time. TUESDAY DO NOT GIVE UP

I READ: Acts 17:22-34, Isaiah 51:7

When we take that first step to witness and evangelize, do not be afraid of different responses from people. There may be those who can immediately accept, but there will be others who refuse and even mock us. Let us keep sowing because that is our part. God's part is changing people's hearts. We must believe that the seeds of the Word we sow will someday grow. Maybe not today they receive it, but when they are in trouble they will remember every word we said. Today we learn from Paul. One time Paul preached to Athenians. Various responses he received, some mocked and rejected the Gospel, but there were also those who believed. For those who rejected the Gospel, Paul left them and did not feel rejected, he believed that he had sown seeds and those seeds will someday grow.

I DECLARE: Isaiah 51:7 - Listen to Me, you who know righteousness, You people in whose heart is My law. Do not fear the reproach of men, Nor be afraid of their insults.

I DO: What action will I take today after meditating the Word of God?

I PRAY: Pray as guided by the Holy Spirit.

ANNUAL BIBLE READING: ISAIAH 31-34

WEDNESDAY GRAB THE OPPORTUNITY

I READ: Zechariah 8:23, Acts 8:1-5

We will be amazed to see that souls from various nations will come to us by themselves because this is harvest time. Don't miss this moment because this golden opportunity will not come again. This may be the last chance for souls to hear about God. Today we will learn from the early church in Acts. When they were persecuted and spread to areas outside Jerusalem, like Judea and Samaria they took the opportunity to evangelize in those new areas. We can also learn from the story of Jonah, how he almost lost the opportunity to preach the gospel to the Ninevites but praise be to God, He gave Jonah a second chance.

I DECLARE: *Zechariah 8:23 - Thus says the LORD of hosts: 'In those days ten men from every language of the nations shall grasp the sleeve of a Jewish man, saying, "Let us go with you, for we have heard that God is with you."*

I DO: What action will I take today after meditating the Word of God ?

ANNUAL BIBLE READING: ISAIAH 35-38

THURSDAY GETTING OUT OF COMFORT ZONE

I READ: Acts 10:9-35, 2 Timothy 4:2

Often we are afraid to evangelize because it forces us to get out of our comfort zone. Sometimes God reminds us to do things that are not comfortable for us, that make us hesitant to do them. Today we are going to learn from Peter. In his day, Jews did not associate with the Gentiles. But one afternoon the Lord gave him a vision, that he must eat food that was forbidden to the Jews however Peter did not understand the meaning of that vision. Cornelius who was an Italian (not Jewish) came to pick Peter up to go his house which for Peter, a Jew, was considered to be unclean but The Holy Spirit strengthened Peter to go with Cornelius. He got out of his comfort zone to evangelize to non-Jews and that moment Peter realized what his vision meant.

I DECLARE: *2 Timothy 4:2 - Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching.*

I DO: What action will I take today after meditating the Word of God ?

I PRAY : Pray as guided by the Holy Spirit.

ANNUAL BIBLE READING : ISAIAH 39-41

FRIDAY BUILD A RELATIONSHIP

I READ: Ruth 1

The story of Ruth and Naomi presents a good example of how we can win souls. Naomi was an Israelite. When there was a famine in Israel, she together with her husband and their children moved to Moab, a nation that worshipped idols. While they were there, Naomi's sons got married to the Moabites. She was even close to her in-laws even though they were not believers. However, she loved and built good relationship with them. It was proven when her sons died, and Naomi was about to return to Israel. One of her in-laws, Ruth, wanted to go with her. Ruth came to know God because of Naomi's life. She always took care of Ruth. We learn from this story that to win souls, we need to build good relationships with others so they may see the love of Christ in our lives.

I DECLARE: *Isaiah 6:8 - Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying: "Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?" Then I said, "Here am I! Send me."*

I DO: What action will I take today after meditating the Word of God?

I PRAY: Pray as guided by the Holy Spirit.
