SATURDAY GREAT AND MIGHTY

I READ: Psalm 23:1-6

As a shepherd, there were times when David had to spend the night in the field with his sheep's. It was a reflection of him as a good shepherd. He walked around his sheep's. When he walked in the middle of the night, David sang Psalm 23 as worship to the Lord, although deep within his heart, he was probably scared. However, David did not make it as a big deal. He instead built his trust in the Lord by singing praises to Him. Like David, maybe today you also feel scared, confused, or lonely. Sing praises to Him. I DECLARE: *Jeremiah 10:6 - Inasmuch as there is none like You, O Lord.*

I PRAY: Pray as guided by the Holy Spirit.

SUNDAY DEFINITE HOPE

I READ: Joshua 1:1-6

After Moses died, God made Joshua to be the leader of Israel. At the time, Joshua was young, and he had to lead the nation of Israel - a large nation to enter the promised land. He knew that in order to do that, they had to face many battles. Every inch was conquered through a battle. The Lord knew his situation. That was why God promised Joshua that He would never leave or forsake Joshua. Every battle that Joshua faced ended with victory. I READ: John 14:1-6
