

SATURDAY DAY AND NIGHT

I READ: Lamentations 2: 18:19, Isaiah 62: 6-7

Once again, we will discuss more about how a prayer tower is about prayer, praise and worship that is done in unity, day and night in addition to the previous lessons. So why does a church of God need to pray day and night or in other words 24 hours a day for a nation? When we look at the two verses from today's reading, we would find that both verses are talking about a similar thing. I DECLARE: Isaiah 62: 6: I have set watchmen on your walls, O Jerusalem; They shall never hold their peace day or night. You who make mention of the LORD, do not keep silent

I DO: I will pray and worship the Lord in a united prayer.

I PRAY: I will pray with a friend in faith in the prayer tower.

SUNDAY WAGES

I READ: Matthew 6: 33, 2 Timothy 2: 6

God's calling for His churches in America is big. God longs for a city prayer tower, especially one in Washington D.C, to be rise. Even though this might seem like big and new for us, let us strengthen our heart and believe that God's grace will allow us to complete this. Let's try to avoid seeing how big this work is but let us see this as an opportunity and something that God has trusted us with. God has chosen us to do His project and work with Him. While it is true that doing His project/work will require us to make sacrifices, you have to realize that these sacrifices is a sacrifice of praise for God and these sacrifices will please His heart. MONDAY

STANDING FOR THE NATION

I READ: 2 Chronicles 7: 1-14, Jeremiah 29: 7

Through the course of this week, we will learn how we can be active in the prayer tower movement that God is doing these days for His church in these end times. Today we will learn from the story of Solomon when he finished building the temple in Jerusalem. He consecrated the temple (prayer tower) by giving a sacrifice of praise to God and by celebrating the Festival of Tabernacles. After Solomon consecrated the temple, God spoke to him. God gave a message to Solomon of how the people of Israel could keep their blessings and be restored by God. God told him that they had to pray and turn from their wicked ways, 2 Chronicles 7 : 14. These days, God wants us to stand for this nation (stand in the gap), pray for this nation, humble ourselves before God, and represent this nations repentance from its sins. Then God will forgive America and start restoring it. This is our task as God's children who are living in these end times: to pray for the nations where we were placed by God. Pray for the prosperity of the nation because its prosperity will become our prosperity, Jeremiah 29: 7.



I DECLARE: Jeremiah 29: 7: Also, seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the Lord for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper."

I DO: Today I will pray that the Holy Spirit will keep opening the secrets of this prayer tower movement to me so I will understand more and start being more involved in it.

I PRAY: I will pray for my VIP list (a list of the people I know who don't know God) continuously until their lives are changed by God and saved.

PRAYER TOWER

TUESDAY PRAYER

I READ: Jeremiah 29: 11-14, Jeremiah 33: 3

The Lord promises us that His plans for this nation are plans of peace and not of evil, plans for a future that is full of hope. If this happens, then we as His church needs to begin praying and ascending a prayer tower, bringing this nation to mind before the Lord, Jeremiah 29:13, Isaiah 62:6. In a prayer tower, we will pray, praise, and worship the Lord in unity with others in the body of Christ, day and night, as we pray for the nations. Do not sit still, but continually bring this to the Lord's mind. Do not let the Lord remain still before He touches America. First off, as we approach the Presidential Elections this coming November, it is important that we pray for God's will for this nation to be carried out. We must pray that the devil has no way of disrupting this election at all. Starting today, let us begin to pray for this nation, both in our own personal prayers as well as our prayers in the prayer tower.

I DECLARE: Jeremiah 33: 3 : 'Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.'

I DO: I will pray and ask the Holy Spirit to lift up my spirit so that I may take part in this prayer tower movement

I PRAY: I will pray and worship the Lord, praying that the prayer tower in Washington, DC will be able to reach a 24/7 level of activity (24 hours a day, 7 days a week), so that day and night, the body of Christ may remind the Lord to touch America.

WEDNESDAY PRAISE AND WORSHIP

I READ: Psalm 34: 1-9, Psalm 22 : 4

In the prayer tower, we need to often lift praise and worship to the Lord. The Word of God in Psalm 22:4(3) says that the Lord is enthroned in our praises. When we lift our praise and worship, the Lord will be enthroned in America. How amazing would it be if we, His children, can build a throne for Him day and night, so that the Lord will continuously be enthroned in this nation. When the Lord is enthroned in this nation, blessings will start to flow over America. Psalm 34 says that the Lord will release this nation from bondages, the Lord will give this nation freedom from its oppression. The Lord will send angels to protect this nation. The Lord's goodness and blessings will also start to be poured upon this nation. Let us start to praise and worship the Lord in the prayer tower, starting today, for this nation, until the Lord comes down to visit America. Lift up praises of victory, restoration and blessings for this nation.

I DECLARE: Psalm 22: 3 : But You **are** holy, enthroned in the praises of Israel.

I DO: I will pray so the Holy Spirit may enable me to enlarge my life's capacity, so I can start to be involved in the prayer tower movement of this city.

I PRAY: I will pray with my family today so that our family continues to be used by the Lord in our calling and election in Him, especially in this prayer tower movement.

THURSDAY DECLARE GOD'S WORD

I READ: 1 Samuel 17: 40 – 51, Matthew 16: 19

At the prayer tower we need to declare God's Word often. Today we are going to learn from the story of David about how declaring/stating God's Word is so important in our life and how we also need to practice this at the prayer tower. David was not at all affected or intimidated by Goliath's threats against him and his people, verses 43-44. From the story of David, we see the Lord's great power and protection when David believed and started to declare in faith, verses 46-47. With confidence, David said to Goliath, "This day the Lord will deliver you into my hand, and I will strike you..." And rightfully so, the Lord gave David great victory and Goliath was defeated and killed. It is so amazing how victory is ours when we believe and start to declare God's Word. Not only will declaring God's Word bring us victory over the devil, but it will also bring blessings over everything we pray for. An example of this is when we declare God's Word and bless the nations through our Daily Declarations. Afterward, blessings start to be poured out from heaven for the nations, Matthew 16:19.

I DECLARE: Matthew 16: 19: And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

I DO: Today I will start to declare God's Word for my life, and I will also declare the Word for this nation when I pray at the prayer tower.

I PRAY: Today I will pray for the leaders that the Lord has placed above me, whether it be in my family, workplace, and/or local church. And I will bless them through my prayers.

FRIDAY UNITY

I READ: John 17: 20-26, Acts 1: 14

Prayer tower is prayer, praise and worship together in unity, day and night. This means that we as children of God need to unite to pray, praise and worship together day and night. God's Word in John says that God's glory is what allows us to unite. If we use our own strength we will never unite, but if we all experience God's glory, we will love God and that will help us overcome our egos and unite. God's promise to His church during the end times is that His glory will return to His church. The goal of this is so churches can unite and together build prayer towers for their city. God's glory also speaks of God's love. John 17: 26 says that God's glory submerged in His love is what enables us to unite. God's love causes us to joyfully receive one another. God's love covers a multitude of sins and weaknesses, so that we no longer focus on others' weaknesses, 1 Peter 4: 8.

I DECLARE: Acts 1: 14: These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers

I DO: Today I will pray and ask the Holy Spirit to enable me to make the commitment to pray at the prayer tower.

I PRAY: I will pray for the Lord's visitation to happen at tonight's Family Altar (small group meeting).
