

SATURDAY FAITHFUL IN FINANCE

Daily Reading: Luke 16:10-13.

We all are God's treasurers. God wants us to be righteous treasurers with the ability to manage His blessings wisely. The verse we just read above also applies to our way of managing our finances. If we are wise in managing God's blessing, then He will have entrusted us with greater blessings. In Philippians 4:19 states "And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus". This verse is God's promise that we, the children of God will never live in poverty/lack. If there are amongst us that still live in lacking/poverty, we may need to introspect ourselves whether we have been good treasurers or not. A good treasurer will know priority and non-priority expenditure and able to take control from unnecessary spending. They are wise in managing their expenditure on self needs, family needs, ministry needs and to help others. A good treasure will not make money as his/her god/mammon. If we want to be blessed abundantly by the Lord, we need to be a good treasurer that God can trust.

Daily Declaration : 1 Timothy 6:10: "For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness and pierced themselves through with many sorrows".

Daily Action: I want to channel God's given blessings wisely.

Daily Prayer: I pray that the church of God is used to bless this nation.

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SUNDAY FAITHFUL UNTIL THE END

Daily Verses: Matthew 24:1-14.

We are now living in the evil days because the devil is working with maximum capacity to bring as many people as he can to hell. The devil also constantly looks for an opportunity to attack the lives of God's children, and cause them to be discouraged, bitter, oppressed, busy with life matters, and eventually lose their first love and leave the Lord. As we look at what the devil is doing, what we must do is to be watchful and put on the whole armor of God (Ephesians 6:10-18). Cling to the Lord and don't let anyone take away the Crown He has prepared for us. This is the time for us to show the world that we are God's children who are obedient, strong and unaffected with the shakings that are happening. If we are faithful and love the Lord, then Psalm 91 will be our part. At the end of our lives, let us hear the Lord say, "Well done, my faithful servant, you have finished the race well."

Daily Declaration: Matthew 24:13: "But he who endures to the end shall be saved."

Daily Action: I want my life to be led by the Holy Spirit so I can be obedient until the end.

Daily Prayer: I pray that America will return to their first love in the Lord, so they can be spared from many troubles.

MONDAY

KEEPING OUR FAITH IN JESUS

Daily Verses: Hebrews 11.

At the end of Apostle Paul's life, he was able to boast that he has finished the race well and has **kept** his faith. This means that our faith towards Jesus needs to be taken care of or nurtured. The faith at the end of someone's life will determine whether he/she will life an eternal life with Jesus. As a believer, our faith will be tested often. For example, when we are experiencing a heavy problem, are we going to believe in the Lord's promise and help or are we going to find a way out using our own strength and unbeliever's advice? Our faith can also be tested when there are attractive offers that are not according to the Word of God. The question now is what decision are you going to make when given those choices? The characters mentioned in Hebrews 11 were people of strong faith until the end of their lives. They continued to have strong faith even though they didn't receive everything that they put their faith in. These people can be called heroes or witnesses of faith. To be able to keep our faith, we need to be close to God and live a life according to the Holy spirit. By doing so, when problems/shakings come, our faith will be strong until the end.

Daily Declaration: Romans 3:27: "Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? Of works? No, but by the law of **faith**

Daily Action: No matter how tired I am today, I will pray and read the Word of God.

Daily Prayer: I will pray until every one of my family members faithfully follow Jesus until the end.



TUESDAY FAITHFUL TO YOUR CALLING

Daily Reading: Philippians 3:7-14

The Apostle Paul truly understood the meaning of living in God's calling. When God visited Paul on his way to Damascus, his life was changed drastically. He's the only Apostle that ever said, "to live is Christ and to die is gain." After he repented, the Apostle Paul did not stop spreading the Gospel even though he was denied and rejected by many. His spirit was always on fire because he understood the meaning of what is to life. At the end of his life, the Apostle Paul was able to say that he has finished the race well and have kept his faith (2 Timothy 4:7). How about us who have been called by God when we were saved? Are we still living in God's calling? What we do at the end of lives will determine whether we're victorious or defeated in the race that God has placed us in. Matthew 7:21 says- "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven." Let this verse be a reminder that we need to faithfully live in our own individual calling.

Daily Declaration :1 Corinthians 7:24:" Brethren, let each one remains with God in that *state* in which he was called "

Daily Action: No matter the price, I want to diligently work on God's calling in my life.

Daily Prayer: I will pray so that God will bring every church member to live in His calling.

WEDNESDAY FAITHFUL IN DOING GOOD DEEDS

Daily Reading: Galatians 6:1-10.

Mother Theresa is an individual who is well known for her acts of kindness. she faithfully did acts of kindness until the end of her life. From her acts of kindness, we can see that she was doing it sincerely and with the right motivation. She was kind towards everyone, including the poor, the sick, and the castaways of society. She did it without expecting any repayment. She was able to do all of these because she had the heart of Jesus, which was filled with love and compassion. Through her actions, we can clearly see that Jesus was inside of her and His name was glorified through her actions. as believers who know the love and grace of God, let us not focus on our own needs. But let us diligently do acts of kindness and have the right motivation when we help someone. The Word of God states that there will be time when we reap what we sow. We have to remember that the more acts of kindness we commit, the more treasure we are gathering in heaven.

Daily Declaration: James 4:17:" Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do *it*, to him it is sin."

Daily Action: I want to throw away the ego that is preventing me from doing kind things.

Daily Prayer: I am going to pray so that the church will help others who are in need even more these days.

THURSDAY FAITHFUL IN GIVING

Daily Verses: Matthew 25:34-46.

Humans have the tendency to give only if they have fulfilled their personal needs and this is often the case with God's children. If we read the Word of God on giving, it does not say that we give only when we can, but it says that the door of blessing will be opened when we first give. Declare this promise of the Lord when we are giving. For God's children, giving covers two aspects- 1) for God 2) for other human beings. Giving to the Lord can be in these forms- tithe, general offering, and mission offering. Giving to other humans can be in these forms- giving to the poor, people who are in need, and your desire to bless others. There are some people who only give to the Lord and do not bother giving when others around them are in need. There are also others who only give to other humans and not the Lord. The right thing to do is to balance those two scenarios mentioned above. If we are faithful in giving to the Lord and others, it is guaranteed that we will never lack, and our needs will always be fulfilled by the Lord.

Daily Declaration: 2 Corinthians 9:7: "*So let* each one *give* as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver."

Daily Action: I want to be a blessing for my family, ministry, and others who are in need.

Daily Prayer: I pray so that my family can be used by God to be a source of blessing and to provide help to those in need.

FRIDAY FAITHFUL IN WORSHIP

Daily Reading: Genesis 2:1-3.

Our Father God created the heavens and the earth for six days. And on the seventh day He rested. Then God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it. As children of the highest God, this is the pattern that we must follow. On the seventh day (Sunday for us), we must stop working and sanctify it for God by going to the house of the Lord/ church and worship Him. Many children of God believe that they are forced to work on Sundays (Sabbaths) due to the increasing demand of daily needs and the demands of work. We need to remember that God didn't just sanctify the Sabbath day, but he blessed it as well (Genesis 2:3). Therefore, when we obey God's command to rest on the Sabbath day, we will receive blessings. We must believe that our blessings come from the Lord and He adds no sorrow (hard work) with it (Proverbs 10:22). By going to the house of the Lord or church, we show our obedience to God's will and this act will also stop us from drying out our spirit. By resting in His presence, He will refresh our minds and bodies so we can pass another week with fresh strength and anointing.

Daily Declaration: Leviticus 19:30:" You will keep My Sabbaths and reverence My sanctuary; I am the Lord!"

Daily Action: I will continue to worship the Lord wherever I'll be.

Daily Prayer: I will pray that the church of God will continue to reap new souls every Sunday service.
