## SUCCESSFUL LIFE

### MONDAY DIVINE JOY

**I READ:** John 15: 9 – 11, Nehemiah 8: 10

What differentiates the joy offered by this world with joy that comes from the Lord Himself? We all know that the joy offered by the world is temporary and very much influenced by the situations and conditions surrounding us. Often, we realize that this kind of joy is very dependent on the "mood" of our hearts. However, the joy from the Lord is everlasting and is not affected one bit by our situation, conditions or even the "mood" of our heart. Even during the storms, we might currently face, we will be able to stand strong through it all and be filled with thanksgiving if we have the divine joy of the Lord in our hearts. God's word says that when we delight in the Lord, He will give us the desires of our heart (Psalm 37:4). The secret to a successful life is to rejoice in the Lord always.

**I DECLARE:** Philippians 4: 4: Rejoice in the Lord always. Again, I will say, rejoice!

**I PRAY:** I will pray for my VIP List (my list of people who do not yet know the Lord) fervently until their lives are touched by the Lord and they are saved.

## TUESDAY

### THE JOY OF GIVING

**I READ:** Matthew 8: 14, 2 Corinthians 9: 68

Today God reveals again the secret for us to experience a successful life, which is by sowing / giving to the Lord. **I PRAY:** I will pray with my family today for our family's prayer topics

**I DECLARE:** Psalm 119: 105: Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

**I DO:** Today I will renew my commitment in meditating and declaring God's Word every day.

**I PRAY:** Today I will pray with my family for our family's VIP prayer list.

## THURSDAY

### INCREASING OF FAITH

**I READ:** Romans 1: 1617, Matthew 19: 26

Everything became possible for us through the death of Jesus Christ on the cross. Through His sacrifice, all our weaknesses, poverty, illnesses, and curses were borne by Him. **I READ:** Ephesians 1: 17 – 23, Hosea 6: 3
