VICTORY OVER THE WORLD

I READ: 1 John 5: 1 – 5

The Lord's promise today is so comforting and strengthening - that He has overcome this world! The world symbolizes the devil and everything he does. The Lord has defeated it with a glorious victory. If the devil has been defeated, it is a very good sign for us that nothing is impossible and that miracles will surely happen in our lives. Because God has overcome this world, it means we who believe in Jesus as the Son of God also have overcome this world, verses 1 and 4. We do not need to fear anymore. Do not be deceived by the devil who tries to trick us into thinking that we have not won, that he is still rampant, and so on. Declare with a loud voice and remind him that he has lost and that he can no longer make an impact in invading our lives.

I DECLARE: 1 John 5: 4: for everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith.

I DO: Today I will look myself in the mirror and declare with faith: "I am more than a conqueror, I am loved by the Lord, I am righteous because of the blood of Jesus, I will be the head and not the tail, I will experience "increase" because Jesus has already died and risen for me!

I PRAY: I will pray often in the Spirit and ask the Holy Spirit to fill my life once again. I will also continue to pray for my VIP list and invite them to join our online Sunday Service tomorrow.

SUNDAY

A FUTURE FULL OF HOPE

I READ: Jeremiah 29: 11 – 14

On this Passover day, the Lord again gives us an awesome promise, that we have a future full of hope and peace. God's has always had a good plan for us. Plans of harm do not come from the Lord but from the devil. But today we do not have to fear, because the Lord will not allow the devil to carry out his plans. Even if the devil wants to carry out evil against us, the Lord will turn it around to work for our good, Romans 8:28. If the devil wants to fill our lives with situations that may seem impossible, God will turn them around to become possible. For with God, nothing is impossible - He has even raised the dead. For everything that the devil says is impossible, the Lord says that it is possible. Do not be afraid or worried.

I DECLARE: Romans 8: 28: ... And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

I DO: Today I will give the best of my life to the Lord during our Sunday service. Whatever the Lord reminds me to give to Him (whether it be praise and worship, monetary offerings, etc.), I will do it joyfully because He loves me so much.

I PRAY: I pray that today's online Sunday Service, His presence and visitation satisfy my heart

NOTHING IS IMPOSSIBLE

MONDAY

IT IS FINISHED

I READ: Isaiah 53: 1 – 12

Isaiah 53 illustrates Jesus' suffering on the cross. His last words on the cross were: "It is finished!" This word is originated from the Greek word *teleo*, which means 'debt that has been paid.' When Jesus died on the cross, He paid all the wages of our sins. The Lord Jesus has finished it all for us. We cannot finish our wages of sins with our own strength. Through His work on the cross, all of our sins are forgiven, and we have been made righteous because of His blood and we can now receive all of the heavenly blessings. Jesus has done His part; our part now is to believe in His work and receive it with faith. If these days we are experiencing problems, believe that Jesus has borne everything and there is nothing impossible for us. Victory is ours.

I DECLARE: Isaiah 53: 5: But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for

our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.

I DO: Throughout this week, I will continue to remind myself that Jesus has borne all my sins, curse and problems on the cross, and He has replaced them with blessings, victory and freedom.

I PRAY: I will pray with thanksgiving, because His love enough for me.

TUESDAY

GREAT THINGS AWAIT...

I READ: John 14: 12-14

When Jesus lived on Earth, He always did great things. Miracles and signs of wonder always followed Him. The blind could see, the dead rose, those who were bound by dark powers were set free. He also walked on water during a storm, He even calmed the storm in an instance, He turned water into wine, and there are many more amazing things that He did. The Word that we read today says that if we believe in the Lord Jesus, then we too can do all the things that He has done. If we truly believe, then nothing will be impossible for us because we are able to do great things and things that seem impossible will be possible. How can we believe in God? If we see His cross and the power of His cross and are sure that the Lord loves us and believe in His grace, then our faith will rise. Faith is what enables us to do great things, in fact even greater than the things that Jesus Himself ever did.

I DECLARE: Philippians 4: 13: I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

I DO: Starting today, I will meditate often on the Lord's cross, His love, and His grace, so my faith will rise up until I am able to do great things in my life.

I PRAY: I will start to practice praying by declaring the Word, until it becomes a part of my lifestyle.

WEDNESDAY

AN ACT OF FAITH

I READ: Matthew 17: 14 – 20

Jesus taught His disciples how to experience miracles and changed what is impossible to something that is possible. The first thing Jesus did was to remind them to have faith (verse 17 and 20). After that Jesus taught them to practice their faith through their actions. How do we do this? Read verse 18. In verse 18, Jesus cast away the evil spirit that took control of the sick child. If we trust God, we're going to have the courage to do spiritual warfare. Spiritual warfare means to pray to cast away all the evil spirits that try to disturb our life. In verse 20, Jesus said to declare the Word of God and to say words of blessings. Jesus told the mountain of problems to move and never come back. Moving a mountain might seem impossible but it will happen if you do it by faith.

Daily Declaration:

Hebrews 11 : 1 : Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

I DO: I will start doing acts of faith by declaring the Word of God often and do spiritual warfare. I do not need to be afraid because God is always on my side.

I PRAY: I will lift up my worship to God until I feel His presence and love. I will continue to pray for people in my VIP (very important people) list and will start inviting the people in that list to join online Sunday Service.

THURSDAY

THE MIND OF CHRIST

I READ: Philippians 4: 6 – 9, 13

To experience God's miracles, we cannot be filled with worry. That will only make our faith shake. Ask God to fill our hearts with His peace. If our hearts are still, we can focus on God and His grace until our faith arises. When we become still, then we can think of things as mentioned in verse 8. Ask God to fill our thoughts with Christ-like thoughts, which are righteous thoughts, just thoughts, and holy thoughts, which allow us to not be affected by bad thoughts or worries. If our hearts and minds are filled with Christ's love and thoughts, we will experience His miracles soon. There is nothing that's impossible for us who believe in Him. If our thoughts are righteous, all our problems will be able to be finished with victory in Him, verse 13.

I DECLARE: Colossians 3: 15: Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful.

I DO: Today, every time a negative thought comes into my mind, I will cast it away in the name of Jesus Christ and declare a lot of God's word so my thoughts will be filled with His word.

I PRAY: I pray faithfully for peace and salvation in America.

FRIDAY

FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT

I READ: Zakaria 4: 6 – 9

All of us surely want to experience victory in our problems. If there is a big mountain in front of us, we would surely want that mountain to be flat land. Can that happen though? Of course, it can. According to the reading above, that thing is very possible. How? God teaches us through today's Word to not rely on our own strength and thoughts in finishing our problems, but to rely on God through the Holy Spirit that is in us. If the Holy Spirit is in us, then God's power will become real, acts 1:8, until our problems are finished by His power. How can the Holy Spirit live in us? We have to always ask and pray to God that He fills us up with the Holy Spirit and pray a lot in the spirit.

I DECLARE: Acts 1 : 8 : But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

I DO: Today I will pray in the Spirit until I feel new strength filling my heart.

I PRAY: I will lift my intercessory prayers for people who I know who are experiencing problems so they may be given strength and may be answered in prayer in God's time.
