FERVENT IN SPIRIT

I READ: Romans 12: 11 – 16

One thing that keeps God's children from living out His calling and election for their life is that they are not diligent in keeping their spirit fervent. What causes someone to stop being fervent in spirit? The answer is found in Romans 12:11. Allowing our ministry to lag in diligence will open the way for our spirits to die out. These days, carry out everything that the Lord trusts in your life in earnest, whether it is related to your life, ministry, or with evangelism. Do not let the pressures of life allow you to become lax. Do not let go of anything that the Lord has entrusted in your life. Do not leave behind or reduce the ministry that you are taking part in. If your spirit is no longer fervent, then you will see ministry and evangelism as something that isn't has lost its importance in comparison to your daily needs.

I DECLARE: Luke 12: 35: "Let your waist be girded and your lamps burning..."

I DO: Today I will renew my commitment in my ministry to the Lord and ask the Holy Spirit to give me strength to carry out the Lord's calling for my life and to win lost souls.

I PRAY: Today I will pray for the leaders who God has placed above me. Whether they are in my family; workplace, or in my local church, I will bless them through my prayers.

I READ: Ephesians 1

The Apostle Paul wrote a letter to the congregation in Ephesians in which he reminded them that the Lord Jesus has chosen and redeemed them with one purpose. That purpose is to receive all the spiritual blessings and grace of God (Ephesians 1: 3 & 6). In addition, God has also granted us His glory.

This letter was intended for His church at the end time. God promised that His glory will return to His churches and all the spiritual blessings and grace will also be given abundantly to His churches. God will also equip His churches with His power through the Holy Spirit (Ephesians 1:13, 14, and 20). The amazing power of the Holy Spirit, which allowed the resurrection of Christ and has defeated the principalities and spiritual forces in the heavenly places (the devil's kingdom), has been given to us. Because of this, the church of the end time should rise up and

bring God's glory, power, and grace to the souls and nations.

I DECLARE: Ephesians 1: 22: And He put all *things* under His feet, and gave Him to *be* head over all *things* to the church

I PRAY: I will pray for God's anointing upon pastors, church workers and everyone who join online service today.

BEARER OF GOOD NEWS

I READ: Romans 10: 9-15

PERSONAL ENCOUNTER WITH GOD

I READ: John 4: 5 - 26, 39

In order to have a great desire to preach the gospel and to bring our friends to receive the salvation in the Lord, we have to experience something like what the Samaritan woman experienced. The Samaritan woman encountered God personally and it changed her life. The Lord visited her and talked with her. He didn't judge her for all the sins that she had done throughout her life but instead He invited her to believe in Him, which can be seen in verse 21. God's great love and grace caused this woman to repent. Not only did the Samaritan woman repent, but she also started to preach the gospel to her friends in her city. Experience a personal encounter with Him and have a personal experience in walking with Him. When we can establish this, we will be excited to bring our friends to the Lord. The purpose is so that they too can experience a wonderful journey with God.

I DECLARE: John 4 : 23 : But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.

I DO: Today, I will make time to have a fellowship with God. I will make the to pray, worship, and read His word, so that I can continue to experience the personal encounter with God.

I PRAY: I will pray for America in order to overcome the Covid 19 pandemic completely.

WEDNESDAY

OBEYING TO TESTIFY

I READ: Jonah 1 : 1-17, Jonah 2 : 9 – 10, Jonah 3

We learn one very valuable lesson from the story of Jonah. Let us obey the Lord when he reminds us to testify and evangelize. Do it immediately!

Today we learn from the story of Jonah. God called Jonah to preach about salvation to the great city of Nineveh, but Jonah refused.

He then went through struggles where he was even swallowed by a big fish and remained in the belly of the fish for three days and three nights. He finally repented and went back to God's calling.

Imagine if Jonah did not obey, then the whole city of Nineveh would have experienced punishments for their wickedness and for not knowing God. Praise God that at the end Jonah obeyed and as a result the whole nation of Nineveh was saved by God.

Let us have a big compassion for all the souls that are lost, so that we can obey and not procrastinate in preaching the gospel to them.

I DECLARE: Isaiah 6 : 8 : Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I. Send me!"

I DO: Today, if the Holy Spirit moves me to start to testify to souls, I will obey and do it immediately.

I PRAY: Today I will especially pray for the people in my VIP list. These are the people that I have been diligently praying for so that they can be saved and know the Lord Jesus.

THURSDAY

HAVE INTEGRITY

I READ: Genesis 39: 1-6, 20-23, Genesis 41 : 37-45

As children of the light, our lives will be open and seen by all people. If we guard the integrity of our lives, we will become an example for others and can win many souls for the Lord. Like Joseph, who always did everything with his full effort, even though what he was doing was work that was meaningless in the eyes of man(as a slave and jail worker), he did it seriously as he would for God, making his life a testimony to many people. I PRAY: I will lift an intercessory prayer for America especially for presidential elections that are getting closer.

ENLARGE YOUR CAPACITY

I READ: Isaiah 54 : 2 – 4

How can we affirm the Lord's calling in our lives? One way is by enlarging our life's capacity. These days, we need to multiply the things God has trusted us with in our lives, such as talents/gifts, riches, intelligence. The Lord reminds us not to spare, or in other words, not to be frugal/calculative with the Lord. He gave us His life without being frugal/calculative toward us. I PRAY: I will pray with my family today so that our family can be used more by the Lord in His calling for us
